

Lane Closure Alert

County to restripe SW 106th/SW 107th Street

King County Road Services will restripe part of SW 106th/SW 107th Street in White Center between 16th Avenue SW and 27th Avenue SW. The road will get a new center turn lane between two through lanes, and will better accommodate bicycles.

The work will happen this month (watch for signs on the road a few days before it starts). It will last 3–5 days, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day. All lanes will be open 6–8 a.m. and 4–6 p.m.

At other times, at least one lane will remain open with flaggers directing traffic. **No parking will be allowed along this part of the road during the project.**

Travelers should expect delays in the area. The schedule may change due to weather conditions.

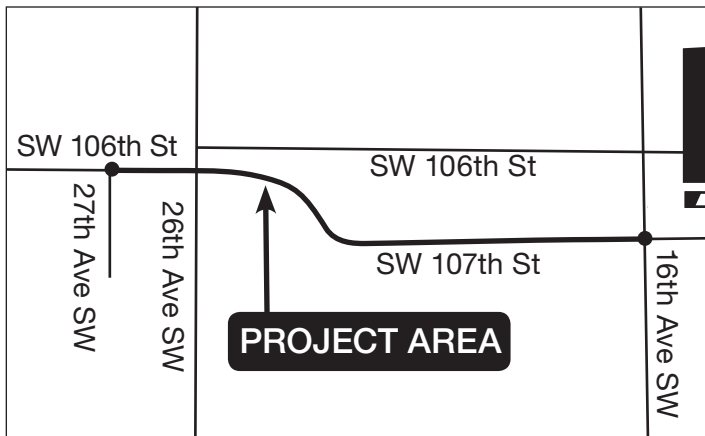
